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

Message from Nick Tallamy, Chair of Governors

As you know, we had our consultation exercise on the joining of the Teignbridge Learning Trust recently. I am in the process of completing a report based on the questions that were raised during that period, which will be with you all shortly. All of the parents that attended the meetings or submitted their views and questions via email were very supportive of the schools move to the Trust. Some parents are sceptical of the idea of a MAT in general, but are aware that the governors have considered everything and have not come to their decision lightly.

There have been a number of events that I would like to advise you about relating to the timeline. As you are aware the original intention was for Cockwood to join the MAT from May 1st, 2018. Due to a delay in the funding becoming available from the Department for Education, it was decided to postpone this until the beginning of the next financial year, which for Multi-Academy Trusts begins in September. We have since been asked by the Department for Education to postpone further to October 2018, as they are currently inundated with applications.

Therefore, the new proposed date for joining the Teignbridge Learning Trust will be October 1st, 2018.
